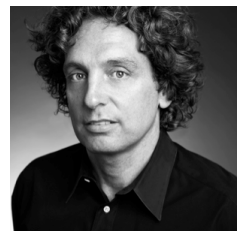
**Cincinnati Youth Choir is now accepting applications
